What does my child need?

- School uniform ensuring it is labelled

Breakfast Club is open 8:15-8:30am. It is free and you do not need to pre-book.

At 8:30am the children will be taken to the playground with our Pupil Support Workers.

The Journey to Primary 1

On the page below you will find a calendar of events for all children starting Primary 1 in August. This transition calendar shares the events that we run in school, including a chance to play in the classrooms during a session in the holidays. A video is also be shared with you which you and your child can watch and our class teachers will be a part of the video.

Please be assured that we are flexible with our transition and if your child requires an enhanced transition in August with shorter days or earlier/later start times, we can accommodate this on an individual basis. Please get in touch by email or speak to one of the school staff on transition days if you feel this may be beneficial.

November 2024	Our Primary 6 pupils support Literacy within our ELC on a weekly basis. Our Early Years
onwards	Practitioners closely observe the relationships that are formed during this time and this helps us
	match up children for our P1-P7 buddy programme. Every P1 will be allocated 1 or 2 buddies to
	support them through their first year at school. If your child does not attend our ELC we will
	discuss this with their current ELC and match them as we see fit.
